Below are some upcoming events that Bill would like everyone to know about and make sure that you go to our website at CCPB.US as there is a lot of information on it regarding events etc. Bill is still working on updating the website along with a few issues in the system.

- On February 7, a Sunday, Hooked on Driving (HOD) is having a track day. There will be seven 25 min. sessions where you can go on to the track and exercise your car. There are three categories, Novice, Intermediate and Advanced. For novices there are driving instructors that will teach you racing basics.
